Sealed bids will be received by the DIRECTOR OF HOUSING of THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION, at the Tribal Offices, **located at 26 Father Joe Murphy Drive, Shawnee, Oklahoma 74801, until 10:00 o'clock A.M., Central Local Time, on the 26th DAY OF JANUARY, 2010** for the CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION HOUSING AUTHORITY FATHER MURPHY COMPLEX IMPROVEMENTS, HUD PROJECT No. 09CT4024380. The projects consists of GRADING, DRAINAGE, PAVING, and SITE UTILITIES. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud by the DIRECTOR OF HOUSING of THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION, at the Tribal Offices, **located at 26 Father Joe Murphy Drive, Shawnee, Oklahoma 74801, beginning at 10:00 o'clock A.M., Central Local Time, on the 26th DAY OF JANUARY, 2010. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, before the time set for opening of bids, as well as bids received after the time set for opening of bids, will not be considered and will be returned unopened.**

Plans, specifications, and other bidding documents are available and copies may be obtained with a NON-REFUNDABLE PAYMENT to the Citizen Potawatomi Nation, in the amount of FIFTY Dollars (\$50.00), at the Office of the DIRECTOR of Housing, located as follows:

A cashier's check, a certified check, or a surety bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of total bid shall accompany the sealed bid of each bidder. Each bid submitted is a legal offer and when accepted by THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION HOUSING AUTHORITY constitutes a FIRM AND BINDING CONTRACT. THE CITIZEN POTAWATOMI NATION HOUSING AUTHORITY reserves the right to REJECT ANY or ALL BIDS, AND the right to cancel all or any portion of this project within thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids, for any reason and at its sole discretion.

Contracts for work under this proposal will obligate the contractors and sub-contractors not to discriminate in employment practices. Contractors will be expected to show good faith compliance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 (12 USC 1701u).

Award of this contract is subject to a determination by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that the contractor is eligible to contract for federally funded activities.
